During these unprecedented times we have altered our normal business practices to coincide with Public Health regulations and recommendations for your safety. **NON-COMPLIANCE PENALTIES OR FINES WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE INDIVIDUAL(S) IN VIOLATION.**

1. The Purple Thistle Dining Room will be open for Breakfast and Dinner service. Hours will be determined by demand and will be posted at the entrance to the restaurant and at the front desk
2. Stanley’s Restaurant above the Pro Shop will be open daily for lunch service. Hours will be posted at the Entrance of Stanley’s and at Front Desk. Guests are encouraged to get take out from this restaurant while limited seating capacity is available
3. Beverage Service is available for pick up at front desk during Front Desk hours of operation (10am-11pm)
4. Our Spa will be opening the week of June 15 with limited hours of operation and by appointment only. Pool facilities are closed at this time until further notice.
5. Hand sanitizing stations are available at all points of entry/exit from our buildings that are in service
6. Transactions for goods and services are being provided using debit or credit card only
7. Housekeeping staff will not be servicing rooms during your stay. Should you require additional linens or supplies they will be delivered to your door. Used linens are to be left in the closet of your room in blue plastic bags provided for pick up following check out. Please tie the bag closed.
8. All surfaces in your room have been sanitized with approved cleaners and staff have serviced your room with appropriate PPE in place.
9. Guests are encouraged to use washrooms in their rooms. Public washrooms in Main Lodge and Corson House will be cleaned once daily in the morning
10. Front desk hours are 9am – 12am. For emergency services after hours guests can contact our on-call staff member at (902)285-4222.



## Safety at the Golf Course

The Province of Nova Scotia has mandated the following practices for golfers while at any course in Nova Scotia. Any penalties or fines for golfer non-compliance will be the responsibility of the offending golfer(s)

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1. **Walk-on Tee Times are currently not permitted. ALL golfers must book a tee-time in advance or they will be turned away. Non-compliance is not an option. The Government of Nova Scotia has made it clear that tee times must be followed to ensure distancing.**
  2. A selection of "Grab and Go" food items and beverages are available at the Pro Shop
  3. Stanley's Restaurant will be open for Lunch service – take out is encouraged due to limited seating capacity
  4. Arrival areas will be managed to ensure that physical distancing is observed at all times, with a minimum of two metres between individuals.
  5. The practice areas will be managed to ensure that physical distancing is observed at all times, with a minimum of two metres between individuals.
  6. Tee time intervals will be managed to ensure groups are evenly spaced throughout the entire round.
  7. Groups will consist of no more than four (4) golfers.
  8. Groups will be directed to the tee to start their round.
  9. Pro Shop will be open for retail sales following Provincial distancing and capacity regulations as outlined
  10. Washrooms will be open in the clubhouse and on the golf course and cleaned once daily.
  11. Bunkers will not have rakes in them
  12. Flags Sticks **MUST NOT** be touched.
  13. Devices are located in the cups to avoid the ball from dropping entirely into the cup. These devices cannot be removed.
  14. Ball washers have been removed from the course
  15. Benches and chairs have been removed from the course
- Power carts must be used by one individual **unless** being shared by **members of the same household or by a "bubble family" member**
  - Power carts and pull carts are cleaned and disinfected before and after each use.
  - Rental clubs and pull carts are available and will be sanitized after each use.
